

Accommodation Options

Magnetic Island is mostly National Park, with the populated area mainly on the East Coast over a distance of about 10km. Once here, it isn't far to anywhere. You can bring your car over but the barge must be booked, and current rates are \$238 return. You can book a car park at the ferry terminal I think for \$5/day and catch the ferry over. Current rate is \$38 return. You may be able to get a concession. When we have our numbers, we will apply for a bulk price on your behalf. Buses meet all ferry's and drop off to most resorts and cross streets. Bushwalking and snorkeling and fishing are the most popular activities. There is a low risk of stingers in the water as they are mainly present over the summer when the water is much hotter. Water temperature in May and August is generally 24 or close to it. There is no surf as we are behind the Great Barrier Reef.

Arcadia Hotel

Family rooms have a king bed (which can split to 2) & 2 singles. \$185 per night for 4 people sharing.

Standard rooms have a King bed, which can split to 2 \$155 per night

All rooms have fridges, kettles, toaster, microwave, and cutlery and there is also a bbq on the premises as well.

This resort is short walk to our competition venue.

The Pub is next door (Arcadia Pub) which can offer meals, is on the Bus route, and has entertainment such as Trivia Nights, Toad Races. We are a quiet Island, and most Pubs shut well before 10 most nights.

Stage Door Theatre Restaurant is a short walk. This is worth attending, but only operates on Friday and Saturday nights so worth coming or staying a few extra days if you have time.

There is a patrolled Beach across the road, and a pool on site

Once you google the island you will find many tours available. The sunset cruises are popular and vary in price and vessel.

I have already mentioned Stage Door Theatre Restaurant, and the Pub nights at Arcadia Pub.

Catch the bus to "The Forts" This walk is very popular and you are almost guaranteed to spot Koala's in their Natural environment Its about 3.5km to the top and back, taking about 1.5 hours for a moderately fit person. From this spot you can also walk to our best beaches where you will feel that you're the only person around. Arther Bay is less than 1km, Florence another K or so, and Radical about 3 Km from the Bus. You can do a loop across to Horseshoe Bay, which is quite demanding as it is steep, but you will find the Marlin Bar and the bus to take you home.

The Marlin Bar is a popular spot to enjoy happy hour (4-6 daily) and watch our famous sunset, but don't leave too early, the colors come later, when the sun sets AGAIN behind Townsville.
